Countywide Disability Resources

These programs support disabled individuals anywhere in Montgomery County.

- **The Arc of Central Alabama** — Advocacy, employment support, independent living programs, and services for individuals with developmental disabilities.
- **Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services – Montgomery** — Vocational rehabilitation, independent living, assistive technology, and disability support services.
- **United Way of Central Alabama** — Referrals to disability-related programs, community support, and nonprofit services.
- **211 Alabama** — Countywide referral line for disability services, housing, food, and long-term support.
- **The Corina Mae Foundation** — Statewide disability-support organization providing help navigating services, contacting programs, advocating for disability rights, and promoting public awareness across Alabama.

Montgomery

Montgomery has the largest number of disability-specific programs in the county.

- **United Cerebral Palsy of Central Alabama** — Therapy, early intervention, adult day programs, employment services, and family support.
- **ADRS Montgomery Office** — Vocational rehabilitation, independent living, and assistive technology.
- **Montgomery Area Mental Health Authority** — Services for individuals with developmental disabilities and co-occurring conditions.
- **Easterseals Central Alabama** — Employment support, vocational training, and disability services.
- **Montgomery Public Transit Paratransit Services** — Accessible transportation for disabled residents.

Pike Road

Pike Road is a growing community with limited disability-specific programs.

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Montgomery and countywide services.

Hope Hull

A small unincorporated community with no local disability organizations.

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Montgomery and countywide services.

Grady

Rural community with no disability-specific programs.

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Montgomery and countywide services.

Ramer

Small rural area with no disability-specific programs.

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Montgomery and countywide services.

Smaller Communities (Snowdown, Mount Meigs, Cecil, Waugh, Sprague)

These areas do not have local disability-specific programs.

- **No disability programs** — All disability support comes from countywide agencies or Montgomery-based organizations.
