Countywide Disability Resources

These programs support disabled individuals anywhere in Madison County.

- **The Arc of Madison County** — Advocacy, employment support, independent living programs, and services for individuals with developmental disabilities.
- **Ability Plus** — Residential services, community support, and independent living assistance for disabled adults.
- **TARCOG Aging & Disability Services** — Disability resources, caregiver support, transportation assistance, and long-term services.
- **United Way of Madison County** — Referrals to disability-related programs, community support, and nonprofit services.
- **211 Alabama** — Countywide referral line for disability services, housing, food, and long-term support.

Huntsville

Huntsville has the largest number of disability-specific programs.

- **The Arc of Madison County** — Developmental disability services, employment programs, advocacy.
 - **Ability Plus** — Residential and community-based disability support.
 - **United Cerebral Palsy of Huntsville** — Therapy, early intervention, adult programs, and family support.
 - **Huntsville Transit Access (Handi-Ride)** — Paratransit transportation for disabled residents.
 - **Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services – Huntsville Office** — Vocational rehab, independent living, assistive technology, and disability support services.

Madison (City of Madison)

Madison has fewer programs than Huntsville, but still offers meaningful disability support.

- **Madison City Disability Support Services** — Accessibility support, accommodations, and community inclusion programs.
 - **Madison Public Library Accessible Services** — Assistive technology, accessible materials, and inclusive programming.
 - **Inside-Out Ministries** — Limited disability-related assistance through community support and referrals.

Gurley

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Huntsville and countywide services.

New Hope

- **No disability programs** — Residents use Huntsville and countywide resources.

Owens Cross Roads

- **No disability programs** — Countywide and Huntsville programs serve this area.

Triana

- **No disability programs** — Residents rely on Madison and Huntsville services.

Smaller Communities (Harvest, Hazel Green, Meridianville, Toney, Moores Mill)

- **No disability programs** — All disability support comes from countywide agencies or Huntsville-based organizations.
